☐ Secondary aisles = vertical to the main entrance and back of hall /venue	$\Rightarrow$	<ul> <li>Aisle width is 2.5m</li> <li>Must be kept clear and unobstructed at all times</li> </ul>		
EXITS - Emergency Egress				
☐ Emergency Exit /Egress = exit doors with panic hardware and lit emergency exits	$\Rightarrow$	<ul> <li>Must be kept clear at all times</li> <li>Clear of registration tables /booths</li> <li>Chairs /benches</li> <li>Merchandise</li> <li>Product booths</li> <li>Food and/or beverage</li> </ul>		
☐ Access to Emergency Exit(s)		<ul> <li>Width of emergency exit doors must be maintained to the nearest public aisle(s)</li> </ul>		
Fire Extinguishers / Pull Stations / Fire Cabinets				
☐ Fire Extinguishers	$\Rightarrow$	<ul><li>Must be kept clear at all times</li><li>Access must be 1m straight to device</li></ul>		
☐ Pull Station	$\Rightarrow$	<ul> <li>Must be kept clear at all times</li> <li>Access must be 1m straight to device</li> </ul>		
☐ Fire Cabinet	$\Rightarrow$	<ul> <li>Must be kept clear at all times</li> <li>Access must be 1m straight to device</li> <li>Door must be operable</li> </ul>		
Space Occupancy				
☐ <b>Temp. Lecture/Seminar /Theater areas</b> = A space created (secondary space) separate from the main event space	ightharpoons	<ul> <li>If less than 60 seats – one entrance /exit is acceptable</li> <li>If more than 59 seats – a secondary exit is required</li> <li>If more than 199 seats, all seats must be fastened together, with 1m gap between every 15 rows and every 15 chairs.</li> </ul>		
☐ Event Space = Hall, conference room, booked space	⇨	<ul> <li>All spaces with more than one entrance /exit has a load occupancy card</li> <li>This load occupancy must be maintained</li> <li>Only one entrance /exit is limited to less than 60 people</li> </ul>		

<sup>\*</sup>Note: All fire extinguishers noted above must be commercial use 2A 10BC, tagged and certified. No other extinguisher will be accepted, as per the Alberta Fire Code.
